



This "Family Contribution Requirements" policy from the New Tampa Wildcats outlines a structured system for families to contribute to the organization's operations, especially during game days. Here's a summary:

1. **Contribution Requirement:**

- Families must perform **5 contribution shifts per family** each season to support game day and other activities.
- A deposit check of **\$150** is required, which will only be cashed if the family fails to fulfill the required shifts.
- The check is returned once the family meets the requirement.

2. **Buyout Option:**

- Families may opt to pay **\$150 per athlete** instead of performing the required shifts.

3. **Exemptions:**

- **Board Members, Coaches, and Team Parents** are exempt from the contribution requirement as long as they fulfill the duties of their roles.

4. **Definitions:**

- **Volunteering:** Tasks performed out of goodwill, such as serving as a board member or coach, with no expectation of reward.
- **Contribution Shifts:** Required tasks during game days (e.g., concessions, gate duty, cat shack), each occurring during the two hours before your athlete's game.
- **Fundraising Hours:** Activities to support fundraising efforts, like bake sales or car washes, that may be required by board members or coaches.

5. **Tracking & Management:**

- The **Volunteer Director** is responsible for managing hours, collecting checks, and returning them once the requirements are met.

This policy ensures family involvement in organizational operations while offering flexibility through a buyout option.
